Holiday Benefit Concerts are Happening!!

We are so excited to announce that the Holiday Benefit Concerts will be happening at Our Savior's Corner of Hope Church (1975 S. Garrison, Lakewood, 80227) on December 4 and 11.

For those of you not familiar with the Holiday Benefit Concerts, here is how they work:

- Every teacher is invited to sign up for a concert time slot on Dec. 4 or 11.
- The students of that teacher perform their holiday music during that time slot. You are welcome to run it like you would your own studio recital.
- Please inform your families about the scholarship program provided by FMTA. We provide scholarships for seniors going into music as a major/minor in college. Students can receive up to \$1,000 their first year and \$500 for every consecutive year after that. High school students are also eligible to apply for summer camp scholarships that will cover ½ the tuition.
- We are suggesting that each family donates \$10, but any amount of donation is welcome.
- Families can go to FMTAmusic.org to donate through Paypal. They may also write a check or give cash to you as the teacher.
- Any non-electric scholarship donations collected by the teacher must be sent to our treasurer, Elinore Quander. (395 Spring Ranch Dr. Golden, CO 80401)
